FORMAT OF ENTRIES	Part 1: Book Report All book report entries should be in A4 size (21cm x 29.7cm) and submitted in DOC or DOCX format, using Times New Roman font size 12. The use of assistive writing features on the platform is not compulsory and will not affect the final score. Students are required to state the book title, book author, book publisher and book ISBN in their Microsoft Word file submission. Filenames should include your full English name, your level, and the book title. Use capital letters and separate by hyphens, e.g. CHANTAIMAN-P4-SNOWWHITE. Part 2: Book Cover Design All book cover design entries should be in A4 size (21cm x 29.7cm) and submitted in JPEG or PNG format, with a maximum file size of 50MB. Filenames should include your full English name, your level, and the book title. Use capital letters and separate by hyphens, e.g. CHANTAIMAN-P4-SNOWWHITE.
